



How to Sign a Mobile Phone Contract in Japan

You will need the following:

1. Resident registration.

2. A bank account.

Since opening a bank account takes time, we recommend signing up for a one-month prepaid SIM from GTN before coming to Japan. You can apply in English, Korean, Chinese, Vietnamese, Nepali, or Indonesian. Important points:

1. Please complete your application at least one week before arriving in Japan.

2. Choose to receive your SIM card by mail to your home address.

Please note that while the school provides Wi-Fi for students in the building, there is no Wi-Fi in the dormitory. We appreciate your understanding.

About bicvcle

In Wakayama, it takes about 10 min. from the dormitory to school.

Also, from school to work places (part-time job), or from the dormitory to work places are around 10 min. by bicycle. Life in Wakayama could be more convenient with bicycle.

It is prohibited to get driver's license for both car and motorcycle while students are in school.

It costs approximately 17,000JPY.

Bicycle helmet

In Japan, wearing bicycle helmet may become mandatory in near future.

Therefore, our school requires students to wear helmet for bicycle. The case you have helmet in your country, please bring them with you.

If you don't, you can buy it in our school.

About signature stamp

Partially, it started to not using signature stamp in Japan, however, on some occasions, it is still needed. For that, if it is available to make it in your country, please bring it. Round shape and have a diameter from 12-15mm is recommended.



Bank account

Wakayama College of Global Business recommends to open an account at Japan Post Bank. It has branches and ATMs all over Japan, so even when you continue your education in Japan after WCGB you can continue using the same account. However, at your part-time job in Wakayama you might be asked to open a different account at

National Health Insurance

a different bank.

About part-time jobs

All students in Japan are obliged to enroll in National Health Insurance. When enrolled it covers 70% of medical bills. The remaining 30% have to be paid by the student while attending the hospital. If you get seriously injured or sick the Insurance works for expensive bills as well. 70% (Government's payment) | 30% (Patient's payment)

All medical bills	

Then, all the students of Wakayama College of Global Business are obliged to pay for the International Students Insurance (about ¥ 10,000 per year).

This insurance covers medical bills that go over ¥3,000 (maximum of ¥3,000 you have to pay yourself).

For example, when you have the National Health Insurance, the medical bills for the most common diseases will be: **Cold** min ¥1,000 Stomachache min ¥1,000

To be eligible to have a part-time job in Japan you need to get a 資格外活動許可 (Permission to engage in activities other than that permitted under the status of residence previously granted). If you don't have this permission, you won't be able to work in Japan. You can get this document at the airport when you land. This permission allows you to work 28 hours per week maximum. Also, during the school breaks (spring, summer, winter breaks) you will be allowed to work 8 hours per day.
